


## Registration process for Nissan Common Suppliers


To register a new organization approved by Nissan:

- The first person within your organization to register for the Nissan Supplier Portal should be the Supplier Portal Security Admin.
  - The Supplier Security Admin should register the organization and grant/approve user permissions to others as needed.
- You must have a Nissan supplier code before registering in the portal.
  - o Please reach out to your Supplier Portal Security Admin or Nissan Buyer.
- When registering in the portal you must your company email address. Do not use personal email addresses (gmail, yahoo, comcast, etc...)
- If a Supplier organization is already a common supplier registered to Covisint/Open Access Portals, they can request the Nissan Supplier Portal Service Package.
- 1. Log in using one of three methods.
  - a. To log in via Covisint / Open Text Portal with your Supplier Portal UserID and password: Registered Users Sign On.
    - i. Enter UserID and password. Click continue.






b. Second option to login is from other Automotive Portals.




i. Click on Nissan Supplier Portal from this dropdown. Ready on 5/19.







c. Third option to login is from Nissan Portal directly. https://nissansplr.portal.covisint.com



2. Navigate to the IAM Admin Console / CSA Screen:




3. Click on the 3 line hamburger menu icon, then manage organization, then service packages.






4. Click on Request Service Package Icon:



- 5. Type Nissan in the Package name filter:
  - a. Then click Nissan Supplier Portal
  - b. Then click Next Button.






## **GROUP OF THE AMERICAS**

- 6. Add in the organization's approved Nissan Supplier Code. Include leading zeros for a full 10-digit number. Ex: 000XXXXXXX. Direct and indirect suppliers will have access to the Nissan Supplier Portal. This portal accepts different types of codes (NMX, aftersales, prototype, local, etc...).
  - a. Add request reason.
  - b. Click Next.




- 7. Click the Terms and Conditions button and read and accept.
  - a. Click on the checkbox and the Accept Button for Terms and Conditions.
  - b. Click Accept.






8. Since you have already registered as a Covisint User, you will get a message like below that will assign you to the Nissan Supplier Portal.

If you are not the registered supplier Admin, your organization's Supplier Portal Security Admin will need to approve your request.




a. Nissan Supplier Portal service package request was submitted.







b. The Supplier Portal Security Admin will receive the request.



c. The Supplier Portal Security Admin will approve the request by clicking Approve and Submit.




Then when Supplier User logs in - they now see the Nissan Supplier Portal grant in their Service packages.





Now when a Supplier that has multiple OEM grants, you will be able to see the Nissan Supplier Portal under Automotive Portals.








1. Click on Login




2. Enter User ID and password. Click Sign In



If you need assistance, click on Help.





4. If you select e-mail, you will get a 4-digit code via email.




5. Enter the 4-digit code. Click Verify.
